

What is College and Career Readiness?

Students who are ready for college and career can qualify for an entry-level, credit-bearing college course leading to a baccalaureate degree, a certificate, or a career pathway-oriented training program without the need for remedial or developmental coursework.

Florida Standards and Academic Expectations

Standards represent the goals for what students should learn. Standards are different from curriculum, which means what teachers teach, and how. Federal policies encourage states to adopt high standards. Federal policies do not touch on curriculum, which is a state and local matter. Our state standards are constructed to hold students to a higher academic expectation, preparing them for postsecondary education and/or the workforce.

Title I, Part A Funding
