The school shall not be responsible for the diagnosis and treatment of student illness. The administration of prescription medication and/or medical supplies to a student during school hours will be permitted only when the following conditions are met: 1. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to attend school; 2. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to benefit from his/her education; 3. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be safe; 4. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be healthy; 5. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to participate in school activities; 6. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to learn; 7. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to function in the classroom; 8. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to function in the school; 9. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to function in the community; 10. The medication or supply is necessary for the student to be able to function in the world.

Prescription medications given at school must be provided in original containers with original pharmacy labels. If the student's name and photograph, if possible, must be received in the original container and labeled when possible. School personnel should be informed of any side effects or complication which may result from taking the medication. Parents are responsible for seeing that adequate supplies of the medication are provided for the school. Students that do not bring the medication to school will not be given the medication.
